PRIVACY POLICY

UDI recognizes the importance of and respects your privacy, and appreciates your trust that we will do so carefully and sensibly. As such, we want you to make the most of this website and to feel confident while doing so. The following discloses the information collection, use and disclosure practices for this website.

When you visit the public area of the website, you remain anonymous. However, to the extent you use e-mail links via the website to communicate with UDI and provide us with personally identifiable information, however, you will not remain anonymous. What Personal Information does UDI gather?

The information we learn from customers helps us personalize and continually improve your shopping experience at UDI. Here are the types of information we collect. We ask for personal information in order to provide a product. The information which we ask for is dependent upon the nature of the request being made, but can be summarized as follows: For general inquiries submitted online, we collect an email address and/or phone number in order to answer your inquiry; For order placement, we will collect contact information necessary for order fulfillment, such as name, phone numbers, and address. We also collect billing information such as credit card number. With the exception of sensitive billing information, we receive and store all the data which you provide through our website. You can choose not to provide certain information, but then you might not be able to take advantage of some

of our features. We use the information that you provide for purposes such as responding to your requests, fulfilling your order, customizing future shopping for you, and improving our store. We will sometimes use the information you provide to communicate with you. Information Provided by Your Computer

Whenever you interact with us we receive and store certain information provided by your computer. The information collected includes statistics about your computer like screen resolution, operating system, and which browser you are using. Information provided about your computer is used by UDI in order to customize our site for your computer. This information is also collected and used to analyze potential changes in our website design. We also collect information about what you did on our website.
